



Then in late Winter the Covid virus arrived, schools were shut down, and when six months later they were reopened, this is what we found ...




So, we started to take care of our poor oaks: we changed the pots, we took away the weeds, and we watered them.... And gradually our little plants came back to life




Together we wrote this note....


- Then each pupil chose an element of Nature that they particularly liked
